

SACA INFRASTRUCTURE STRATEGY REFRESH



SACA is undertaking a review and update of the South Australian Cricket Infrastructure Strategy (SACIS). The outcome will be the development of an updated 5-year infrastructure focussed strategy (2025-2030) to guide facility development priorities for all levels of cricket across South Australia.

Shaping the strategy to 2030

The updated SACIS will be influenced by government priorities, facility needs, participation forecasts and audits of the 700+ cricket venues across South Australia. The following stakeholders will be engaged in the process.

- Local Government Authorities
- Officer for Recreation, Sport and Racing
- Community cricket clubs
- Premier clubs and association
- Department of Education
- Cricket Australia
- Other sports

Achievements from the 2019-2029 SACIS

- 45% of change rooms are now gender inclusive – up from 5% in 2019.
- 35% of centre wickets are now compliant – up from 12% in 2019.
- SACA’s \$2M Places to Play Program to provide 100 cricket pitches in schools for school use and community cricket outside of school hours.
- \$4.62M Australian Cricket Infrastructure Funding towards 197 projects with a total project value of \$126M aligning strategically with SACIS direction.
- Partnerships and Shared Investment through the Grassroots Football, Cricket and Netball Facility Funding Program.
