

# SACA Members' Area Dress Standards



The **SACA Members' Area** Dress Standards apply on cricket match days, including cricket match day dining.

## ACCEPTABLE

- ✓ Upmarket casual attire is acceptable as a minimum
- ✓ All attire must be in good condition
- ✓ Members and their guests who identify as male must wear a collared shirt
  - Exception 1** - officially licensed replica on-field player shirts: International teams recognised by the ICC or any other Australian Domestic team recognised by Cricket Australia (including W/BBL) are acceptable to wear.
  - Exception 2** - For W/BBL matches only, all officially branded W/BBL team t-shirts are acceptable to wear (singlets not permitted)
- ✓ Jackets and jumpers are acceptable (Members and their guests who identify as male must wear a collared shirt underneath)
- ✓ Trousers, shorts, jeans, dresses, skirts
- ✓ Leggings/tights (are only acceptable if worn under a dress/skirt)
- ✓ Sports shoes are acceptable but must be in good condition
- ✓ All leather footwear, including sandals and Birkenstocks
- ✓ Cricket Australia / Adelaide Strikers fan giveaway headwear

## NOT ACCEPTABLE

- ✗ Ripped or torn clothing (even if 'designer' tears)
- ✗ Members and their guests who identify as male - shirts without a collar
- ✗ Members and their guests who identify as male - jackets and jumpers without a collared shirt underneath
- ✗ Clothing that is see-through, exposes a midriff or has a lowcut front
- ✗ Attire with obscene or offensive messages
- ✗ Football, running, bike or boardshorts, yoga/gym pants, leggings, work overalls, beachwear
- ✗ Track pants
- ✗ Rubber or plastic footwear (including thongs), Ugg boots, slippers, Crocs or toe shoes
- ✗ Sombreros or any other hats that block other's views must not be worn in the grandstands

# SACA Members' Events

## Dress Standards



The **SACA Members' Events** Dress Standards apply at Member events on non-cricket match days.

### ACCEPTABLE

- ✓ Upmarket casual attire is acceptable as a minimum
- ✓ All attire must be in good condition
- ✓ Members and their guests who identify as male must wear a collared shirt
- ✓ Jackets, jumpers & AFL guernseys are acceptable (Members and their guests who identify as male must wear a collared shirt underneath)
- ✓ Trousers, jeans, dresses, skirts
- ✓ Leggings/tights (are only acceptable if worn under a dress/skirt)
- ✓ Beanies and hats are only acceptable to wear outside function rooms
- ✓ All leather footwear, including sandals and Birkenstocks

### NOT ACCEPTABLE

- ✗ Ripped or torn clothing (even if 'designer' tears)
- ✗ Shorts
- ✗ Members and their guests who identify as male - shirts without a collar
- ✗ Members and their guests who identify as male - jackets and jumpers without a collared shirt underneath
- ✗ Clothing that is see-through, exposes a midriff or has a lowcut front
- ✗ Attire with obscene or offensive messages
- ✗ Football, running, bike or boardshorts, yoga/gym pants, leggings, work overalls, beachwear
- ✗ Track pants
- ✗ Rubber or plastic footwear (including thongs), Ugg boots, slippers, Crocs or toe shoes
- ✗ Sombreros or any other hats that block other's views must not be worn in the grandstands

Anyone aged 10 and over must adhere to the Dress Standards. SACA reserves the right to refuse entry to any Member or guest, if it is deemed that they are unsuitably attired.
